

INFORMATION FOR NON-MCUI (UC) LICENCE HOLDERS/OVERSEAS COMPETITORS WISHING TO COMPETE AT THE ARMOY ROAD RACES 2022

In order to compete in the Armoyn Road Races 2022, as and a **condition of entry**, competitors who do not hold a current valid MCUI (UC) licence **must obtain starting permission, in writing, from their appropriate Governing Body/Federation.**

Also, as a condition of the stated required starting permission, **the competitor must hold Personal Accident (PA) insurance for the specific event.** *It may be possible in some jurisdictions that PA insurance may be obtained directly from the competitor's own Governing Body.*

A copy of **valid Personal Accident Insurance cover must be submitted with your event entry form** (in English language).

In previous years, the MCUI (UC) was able to provide PA insurance cover for overseas competitors, however, this year (2022) the MCUI (UC) is no longer in a position to offer this provision.

Alternatively, to overcome this, Personal Accident insurance can be purchased privately by the competitor by contacting **willisinsurance.co.uk** who are an event specific insurance company who has agreed an indemnity policy per event of approximately £300.

As you will appreciate, whilst everyone hopes that such provision will never need to be utilised, it is a necessity, should a competitor need to avail of medical services and repatriation.

The recommended minimum limits of indemnity required are:-

Death: EUR 25,000

Capital Benefits & Permanent Total Disablement: EUR 50,000

Emergency Medical Expenses: EUR 185,000

Repatriation Expenses: EUR 100,000

Further information on Start Permission & Insurance should be obtained from the competitor's own Governing Body/Federation.

Remember: Start permission from the competitor's own governing body/federation is still required, NO START PERMISSION = NO RACING regardless of Insurance status
